# WHAT IS TRANSFORMATION?

The Bible clearly reveals that human beings are tripartite—that is, we were created by God with a spirit, a soul, and a body (1 Thes. 5:23). The Bible also reveals that God's complete salvation is a salvation that includes our entire tripartite being. First, our spirit is regenerated. This means that our human spirit, the organ by which we contact, receive, and assimilate God, is born of God the Spirit to have the life of God. This is the meaning of being born again. Regeneration, or being born again, is instantaneous. At the coming of the Lord, our body will be transfigured from a body of humiliation into a body of glory, like the resurrected, glorified body of the Lord Jesus. This transfiguration of our body, like regeneration, will also be instantaneous. But there is a very crucial aspect of God's salvation that, unfortunately, is neglected by many very serious students of the Word. This aspect is transformation.

### TRANSFORMATION (continued from page 1)

It is important that we understand the basic truth concerning transformation. Transformation is not a matter of the spirit or of the body, but of the soul—the mind, emotion, and will. Our spirit is regenerated, our body is transfigured, but our soul is transformed. Romans 12:2 says that we are transformed by the renewing of the mind. Second Corinthians 3:18 says that as we behold the Lord, we are transformed into His image from glory to glory. Transformation is an organic life process that brings about a metabolic change in our soul, to make our soul the expression of the Christ who dwells in our spirit. Transformation is not instantaneous but involves a long process beginning from the time of our regeneration. In transformation, the divine element spreads from our spirit into our soul, causing an organic and metabolic change. In this metabolic change, an old element is removed and discharged, and a new element is added to take the place of the old element. As the process of transformation is going on, the old natural element in our soul is discharged and a new divine element is added, causing our soul to be transformed from glory to glory. This results in a change in the constitution of the soul in that a divine element is now a part of our mind, emotion, and will. Furthermore, there is a change in the image within us so that our soul is more and more transformed into the Lord's image to express Him (Rom. 8:29).

God's goal in His economy is to have a corporate expression of Christ through God's redeemed, regenerated people. For this it is not sufficient that we merely be regenerated in our spirit. We need our soul to be gradually transformed from glory to glory, saturated and permeated with the element of God, so that we express God, shine forth God, and glow with God for the glorious expression of God in Christ (2 Cor. 3:18).



## Excerpt from THE ECONOMY OF GOD BY WITNESS LEE

In 1964 Witness Lee gave a series of messages that comprise the book The Economy of God. The following is an excerpt from chapter three entitled "The Residence of the Divine Spirit."

After the Israelites were delivered and saved from the land of Egypt, they were brought into the wilderness with the intention that they should go on into the land of Canaan. The land of Canaan was their land of rest, a type of the all-inclusive Christ. Christ is the good land of Canaan, and He is our Rest. If we are going to enter into the rest, we must enter into Christ. But where is Christ today? We answer that He is in our spirit. The Israelites, who were delivered out of Egypt, instead of going on into Canaan, wandered for many years in the wilderness. What does this typify? It means that many Christians after being saved are simply wandering in the soul. The reason the book to the Hebrews was written is that many Hebrew Christians were saved, but they were wandering in their soul. They would not press on from the wilderness into the good land—that is, into Christ who dwelt in their spirit. We must not continue to wander in our soul, but press on to enter into our spirit, where Christ is our rest.


Let us illustrate further by the following diagram:



In ancient times all the people of Israel had access to the outer court, but only the priests could enter the holy place. Furthermore, into the Holiest of all only one, the High Priest, could enter, and that only once a year. Moreover, of all the Israelites who were saved and brought out of Egypt into the wilderness, very few went on into the good land of Canaan.

Even though we may have been saved for years, we must ask ourselves whether we are presently a Christian living in the body, in the soul, or in the spirit. Are we now in Egypt, in the wilderness, or in the good land of Canaan? Ask the Lord and search yourself in order

to be clear where you are. Frankly, many Christians are wandering all day in the soul, that is, in the wilderness. In the morning they have smiling faces, but by afternoon they are sorrowful with long faces. Yesterday, it seems they were in the heavens, but today they are down. They are wandering in the soul, the wilderness, without rest, circling in the same rut day after day. They may have been following the Lord for twenty years, but are still going in circles, just as the people of Israel, who wandered for thirty-eight years with no improvement and no progress. Why? Because they are in the soul. When we are in the soul, we are in the wilderness.

## THE Path OF Life

Below are excerpts focused on matters and practices of the spiritual life as revealed in God's Word. May the Lord show us "the path of life" (Psa. 16:11) that we may have a daily living of enjoying, experiencing, and gaining Christ.

### THE WAY TO EXPERIENCE LIFE

THE LAW OF THE SPIRIT OF LIFE

Romans 8:2 says, "For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and of death." This verse speaks of four matters: a law, the Spirit, life, and Christ Jesus. The law is of the Spirit, the Spirit is of life, and this law has freed us in Christ Jesus. Christ is the Spirit, the Spirit is life, and with this life there is a law.

With any kind of life there is a certain law. A kind of law always accompanies a life. With the physical life there are many laws. After we eat a meal, there is a law within our body, especially in our stomach, to carry out the digestion. This is an automatic, unconscious action. If something operates unconsciously in us, it is a law. When we have trouble with our stomach, we are conscious of our digestion, but if we are normal and healthy, there is no consciousness of digestion. Rather, there is an automatic working in our stomach, which is a law. . . .

There is always a law within us. We have Christ in us, Christ is the Spirit, and this Spirit is the Spirit of life, even life itself. Within this very life there is a law. In order to know how to experience life, we must know that this very life within us has a law, which is called the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus. With such a law it is so easy to experience life.

#### THE SENSE OF LIFE

Verse 6 goes on to say, "For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the spirit is life and peace." This verse speaks of death on the one hand and of life and peace on the other. How can we know whether or not we are in the spirit? It is simply by checking whether or not we have life and peace. If

we have life and peace, we are in the spirit. If we do not have life and peace, we have death, which proves that we are not in the spirit. . . .

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According to the revelation of the Scripture, we believe that any ministry that comes from God should trust in God for all its needs. 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Therefore, the way to experience Christ as life is simple. Romans 8:2 and 6 give us the way. Christ as the Spirit within us has a law. When we are in life, this automatic law always regulates us to sense peace, joy, happiness, comfort, and ease. When we are not in the Spirit of life, this law regulates us to feel that we are in darkness, that we are weak and do not have peace and rest. We must simply go along with the inner feeling, which comes automatically with the law of the Spirit of life. If we are about to say something that is not in the spirit, not in life, right away the automatic law spontaneously regulates us within. This is something within Christians that is wonderful yet mysterious.

How can we know that we are saved? We have been regenerated with a new heart and a new spirit, and the Triune God as life dwells within us. Our longing heart that loves the Lord is a strong proof that we are saved. In addition, with the Triune God dwelling within us, there is a natural, automatic, regulating law, living and spontaneously regulating us. If we have no law regulating us, it is doubtful that we are saved. When I was young, before I was regenerated, the more I quarreled with others, the more I felt self-glorified. Now after having been regenerated, there is something different within me. The more I quarrel, the more I am sorry. How do we know that we are saved persons? It is simply by the inner, living, automatic, spontaneous regulation. Even when we make a small mistake, something within regulates us. It is a law which is delicate and tender, yet deep and strong. Do not despise this law.

We have a spontaneous regulating law within us. This is the simple way to experience life. Sometimes, simply because we do not have this knowledge, we may go to the Lord and pray that He will help and strengthen us. However, if we neglect this law, no matter how much we pray we will still not be strong. Within us is an automatic law working spontaneously, and this law is unlimitedly powerful.

Praise the Lord, the Triune God as life is within us, and with this life is the automatic law which spontaneously regulates us! If we are in life, this law regulates us to sense life and peace, and when we are not in this life, this law regulates us to sense that we are in death, weakness, and darkness without joy, comfort, satisfaction, and all the items on the positive side. This is the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus. We should simply receive it and apply it day by day. Then we will realize how powerful the law of the divine life is.
