price in full! This is indeed a tremendous truth. Christ died as the Lamb of God to take away the sin of the world (John 1:29).

Although most believers are familiar with Christ's sacrificial death as the Lamb of God for the sins of mankind, the Bible tells us that His death accomplished many other wonderful things. Thus, we may call His death an all-inclusive death. Let us examine what Christ accomplished in His death on the cross.

John's Gospel reveals that Christ died not only as the Lamb of God

(1:29) but also as the brass serpent (3:14). Second Corinthians 5:21 tells us that the Lord Jesus did not know sin in His experience. Just as a brass

serpent does not have the poison of a serpent but only its form, so Christ, as a man, did not have the sinful nature but was in the *likeness* of the flesh of sin (Rom. 8:3). Thus, as the brass serpent, He died to deal not only with our sinful actions but also with our inward nature of sin.

Christ in His death not only dealt with our sins and our sinful nature but He even destroyed "him who has the might of death, that is, the devil" (Heb. 2:14). Two thousand years ago, Christ destroyed the devil himself. The devil is a defeated foe, and we need never be afraid of him!

The Bible also tells us that when Christ died on the cross, we were crucified with Him (Gal. 2: 20). Our "old man" was crucified with Christ (Rom. 6:6). Not only so, the world (the satanic system that enslaves people) was judged and its ruler, Satan, was cast out (John 12:31). Paul says that the world was crucified to him (Gal. 6:14). In His death Christ judged the ruler of the world and his world system.

Christ also died as the peacemaker terminating all the ordinances, which are related to culture and different ways of living, that divide people (Eph. 2:14-15). In Christ there is now peace between the different kinds of people. He is our peace.

Furthermore, in His death, Christ was also a grain of wheat (John 12:24). His death not only dealt

with many negative things but it also released His divine life for His multiplication. His life was released to get into millions of people! As the life in a seed is released by the shell of the seed "dying" after being buried in the earth. Christ's death released the divine life in Him. This marvelous life-releasing death produced us, the believers, to be His church. We are His multiplication, just as the many grains are the multiplication of the one grain that falls into the ground to die. While other aspects of His death deal with negative matters, His dying as the grain of wheat is altogether positive.

Praise the Lord for the all-inclusive death of the Lord Jesus Christ!

Below are excerpts focused on matters and practices of the spiritual life as revealed in God's Word. May the Lord show us "the path of life" (Psa. 16:11) that we may have a daily living of enjoying, experiencing, and gaining Christ.

#### TAKING THE LORD'S PERSONALITY

Suppose I tell a certain brother that I love him. This involves a lot. He is a person with a strong personality, having his own will, desires, and intentions. He also has his likes and dislikes. I say I love him, but does this mean that I ask him to follow my desire? This is not love; this is a demand. If I really love him, I must follow his desire. This is why the Lord told Simon Peter to follow Him after Peter said that he loved Him. The Lord was saying that to take Him as our life

and as our Person, we must take His desire as our desire. We must take His will as our will. We must take His intention as our intention. To love Him as a Person, we must take His personality....

We may have many teachings with all the gifts and power, and yet we would not take the personality of Christ. The Lord Jesus does not need someone who has teachings, gifts, and power. He needs someone like Peter to love Him, someone to tell Him, "O Lord Jesus, I love You! I follow You. I take You as my Person. I take Your personality as my personality. I take Your will as my will. I take Your desire as my desire. I don't care for teachings, gifts, and power. I just care for Yourself. I love You, and I follow You, taking You as my Person."

During the past years of my Christian life, I have heard many teachings, and

I have been taught to do many things. But nothing works unless we love the Lord Jesus. Some people teach that we must reckon ourselves dead with Christ. But if we do not love Him, regardless of how much we reckon ourselves dead, we are never dead. On the other hand, if we say from our heart, "Lord Jesus, I love You; I take Your personality as my personality," there is no need for us to reckon ourselves dead; we are dead already....

Brother John Nelson Darby lived to be over eighty-four years of age. One day when he was quite old, he was

traveling and stayed overnight in a hotel. Before going to sleep, he said to the Lord, "Lord Jesus, I still love You." None of his writings inspired me as much as this

single short sentence. That short word touched my heart. By that time he was quite old, yet he could still speak such a word to the Lord. It was many years ago when I read this. I immediately told the Lord, "Lord, keep me loving You all the time. I just ask you to do this one thing."

#### FOLLOW AFTER LOVE

Give yourself to love the Lord. No other way is so prevailing, and no other way is so safe, so rich, and so full of enjoyment. Just love Him. Do not care for anything else. Teachings, doctrines, gifts, and power do not mean much. We must continually tell the Lord, "Lord, keep me in Your love! Attract me with Yourself! Keep me all the time in Your loving presence!" If we will pray in this way, we will see what love we will have toward the Lord and what kind of life we will live. We will simply live by the Lord Himself. As long as we love Him from the deepest part of our being, everything will be all right. If we need wisdom, He will be the wisdom to us. If we need power, He will be the power. If we need the proper and adequate knowledge, He will even be that to us. Whatever we need, He is. Do not try to get anything else; just look to Him that He would reveal His love to you. Song of Songs 1:4 says, "Draw me, we will run after thee." We must ask the Lord to draw us, and then others will run after Him with us. To take Him as our life, we must love Him in such a way.
